## Privacy Policy

Effective as of May, 10 2024

This Privacy Policy describes how **Chester County Veterinary Services, PLLC (DBA Cypress Veterinary Clinic)**, "we," "us," or "our" handles personal information that we collect through our digital properties that link to this Privacy Policy, including our website and third-party mobile application (collectively, the "**Service**"), as well as through in-person clinic activities, social media, marketing activities, live events, and other activities described in this Privacy Policy.

### 1 - PERSONAL INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT

**1.1 Information you provide to us.** Personal information you may provide to us through the Service, in our clinics, or otherwise includes:

- **Contact data**, such as your first and last name, email address, billing and mailing address, and phone number.
- **Demographic data**, such as your date of birth.
- **Pet data**, such as name, species, age, gender, health history, and insurance information.
- **Communications** that we exchange with you, including when you contact us with questions or feedback, through the Service, social media, or otherwise.

- **Payment and transactional data**, such as information relating to or needed to complete your orders and/or payments on or through the Service (including payment card information and billing information), and your purchase history.
- **Marketing data**, such as your preferences for receiving our marketing communications and details about your engagement with them. Obtained at social events or marketing events
- **Government-issued identification numbers**, such as driver's license or state ID number.
- **Event data**, such as information you share with us in the course of participating in our live events.
- **Other data** not specifically listed here, which we will use as described in this Privacy Policy or as otherwise disclosed at the time of collection.

**1.2 Third-party sources.** We will **NOT** collect or combine personal information we receive from you with personal information we obtain from other sources, such as:

- **Public sources**, such as social media platforms, and other publicly available sources.
- **Private sources**, such as data providers and data licensors.
- **Marketing partners**, such as joint marketing partners and event co-sponsors.

**1.3 Automatic data collection.** We, our service providers, and our partners **WILL NOT** automatically log information about you, your computer or mobile device, and your interaction over time with the Service, our communications, and other services, such as: **We will only log personal information about you and your pet in our medical software program**

- **Device data**, such as your computer or mobile device's operating system type and version, manufacturer and model, browser type, screen resolution, RAM and disk size, CPU usage, device type (e.g., phone, tablet), IP address, unique identifiers (including identifiers used for advertising purposes), language settings, mobile device carrier, radio/network information (e.g., Wi-Fi, LTE, 3G), and general location information such as city, state or geographic area.
- **Online activity data**, such as pages or screens you viewed, how long you spent on a page or screen, the website you visited before browsing the Service, navigation paths between pages or screens, information about your activity on a page or screen, access times and duration of access, and whether you have opened our emails or clicked links within them.

**1.4 Cookies and similar technologies.** Some of the automatic collection described above is facilitated by the following technologies:

- **Cookies** are small text files that websites store on user devices and that allow web servers to record users' web browsing activities and remember their submissions, preferences, and login status as they navigate a site. Cookies used on our sites include both "session cookies" that are deleted when a session ends, "persistent cookies" that remain longer, "first party" cookies that we place, and "third party" cookies that our third-party business partners and service providers place.

- **Local storage technologies**, provide cookie-equivalent functionality but can store larger amounts of data on your device outside of your browser in connection with specific applications.
- **Web beacons**, also known as pixel tags or clear GIFs, are used to demonstrate that a webpage or email was accessed or opened, or that certain content was viewed or clicked.

**1.5 Data about others.** We **WILL NOT** offer features that help users invite their friends or contacts to use the Service, and **WILL NOT** collect contact details about these invitees so we can deliver their invitations (referral program). Please do not refer someone to us or share their contact details with us unless you have their permission to do so.

## **2 - HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION**

We may use your personal information for the following purposes or as otherwise described at the time of collection:

**2.1 Service delivery and business operations.** We may use your personal information to:

- provide, operate, and improve the Service and our business;
- communicate with you about the Service, including by sending announcements, updates, security alerts, and support and administrative messages;
- communicate with you about events or contests in which you participate;
- understand your needs and interests, personalize your experience with the Service and our communications; and
- provide support for the Service, and respond to your requests, questions, and feedback.

**2.2 Research and development.** We may use your personal information for research and development purposes, including to analyze and improve the Service and our business. As part of these activities, we may create aggregated, de-identified, and/or anonymized data from the personal information we collect. We make personal information into de-identified or anonymized data by removing information that makes the data personally identifiable to you. We may use this aggregated, de-identified, or otherwise anonymized data and share it with third parties for our lawful business purposes, including to analyze and improve the Service and promote our business.

**2.3 Marketing and advertising.** We may collect and use your personal information for marketing and advertising purposes:

- **Direct marketing.** We may send you direct marketing communications. You may opt out of our marketing communications as described in the [Opt-out of Marketing](#) section below. .

**2.4 To manage our recruiting and process job applications.** We may use personal information, such as information submitted to us in a job application, to facilitate our recruitment activities and process job applications, such as by evaluating a candidate for a job and monitoring recruitment statistics.

**2.5 Compliance and protection.** We may use your personal information to:

- comply with applicable laws, lawful requests, and legal process, such as to respond to subpoenas or requests from government authorities;
- protect our, your or others' rights, privacy, safety, or property (including by making and defending legal claims);
- audit our internal processes for compliance with legal and contractual requirements or our internal policies;
- enforce the terms and conditions that govern the Service; and
- prevent, identify, investigate, and deter fraudulent, harmful, unauthorized, unethical, or illegal activity, including cyberattacks and identity theft.

**2.6 With your consent.** In some cases, we may specifically ask for your consent to collect, use, or share your personal information, such as when required by law.

**2.7 Cookies and similar technologies.** In addition to the other uses included in this section, we may use the Cookies and similar technologies described above for the following purposes:

- **Technical operation.** To allow the technical operation of the Service, such as by remembering your selections and preferences as you navigate the site.
- **Functionality.** To enhance the performance and functionality of our services.
- **Analytics.** To help us understand user activity on the Service, including which pages are most and least visited and how visitors move around the Service, as well as user interactions with our emails. For example, we use Rhapsody for a medical software, Chewy and VetSource for prescriptions, Vetstoria for online scheduling and PetDesk for phone services. We also use Google Marketing analytics.

### ● [3 - HOW WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may share your personal information with the following parties as otherwise described in this Privacy Policy or at the time of collection:

- **Affiliates.** Our corporate parent, subsidiaries, and affiliates, for purposes consistent with this Privacy Policy.
- **Service providers.** Third parties that provide services on our behalf or help us operate the Service or our business (such as hosting, information technology, customer support, email delivery, marketing, consumer research, and website analytics).
- **Payment processors.** Any payment card information you use to purchase on the Service or in our clinic is collected and processed directly by our payment processors, such as Scratch. Scratch may use your payment data following its privacy policy found at <https://scratchpay.com/legal/privacy-providers>.

- **Professional advisors.** Professional advisors, such as lawyers, auditors, and insurers, where necessary in the course of the professional services that they render to us.
- **Authorities and others.** Law enforcement, government authorities, and private parties, as we believe in good faith are necessary or appropriate for the compliance and protection purposes described above.
- **Business transferees.** Acquirers and other relevant participants in business transactions (or negotiations of or due diligence for such transactions) involving a corporate divestiture, merger, consolidation, acquisition, reorganization, sale, or other disposition of all or any portion of the business or assets of, or equity interests in, Cypress Veterinary Clinic or our affiliates (including, in connection with a bankruptcy or similar proceedings).
- **The public.** With your permission, we may share your pet's information (name and picture) on social media or other outlets. This information can be seen, collected, and used by others, including being cached, copied, screen captured, or stored elsewhere by others (e.g., search engines), and we are not responsible for any such use of this information.

## 4 - YOUR CHOICES

**4.1 Opt-out of marketing communications.** You may opt out of marketing-related emails by following the opt-out or unsubscribe instructions at the bottom of the email, or by contacting us. Please note that if you choose to opt out of marketing-related emails, you may continue to receive service-related and other non-marketing emails.

**4.2 Cookies.** Most browser settings let you delete and reject cookies placed by websites. Many browsers accept cookies by default until you change your settings. ## 8 - CHILDREN

The Service is not intended for use by anyone under 18 years of age. If you are a parent or guardian of a child from whom you believe we have collected personal information in a manner prohibited by law, please contact us. If we learn that we have collected personal information through the Service from a child without the consent of the child’s parent or guardian as required by law, we will comply with applicable legal requirements to delete the information.

## **9 - CHANGES TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY**

We reserve the right to modify this Privacy Policy at any time. If we make material changes to this Privacy Policy, we will notify you by updating the date of this Privacy Policy and posting it on the Service or other appropriate means.
